



JULEICA (D) - CHARACTERISTICS

Purpose and operation

The “Juleica” (Jugendleitercard) is an official german license for volunteers in youth work. The Juleica-training, being situated in the Blossin centre of youth and non formal education, is taking place in cooperation with “brandenburgische sportjugend“ in a two-weekend-course regarding formal guidelines of the “Landesjugendamt“ and following recommendations of the “Landesjugendring Brandenburg“

If all requirements are fulfilled the participants of the training can apply the card (online).

The Juleica have a validation of 3 years. After this period the cards validation can be extended by the youth leaders (“Jugendleiter/in“) in case they can prove, that they still active in voluntary youth work and absolve at min. one retraining.

Affinity group and operational areas

Children and adolescents from 6 to 18 years in:



- holiday camps
- youth clubs
- associative work
- sports/training camps
- open youth work, etc.

Requirements

- Minimum age 16 years
- continuous voluntary activity in youth work
- Presence and active participation in a formation/training about (min.) 40h
- Ability for integration/ team work and self-perception during the training
- Certificate of first aid course (about 16h)

Aims and contents

Module I : Leadership competence

- Process of finding one's own style of leadership as well as the specific ability to reflect on one's own actions and to guide groups of children and adolescents
- Realization and assuming control of certain specifics and changes within a group (group dynamics)
- Knowledge of age- and sex/gender -related properties and psychosocial developments of children and adolescents as well as their specific needs

Module II : Methodical competence

- Knowledge of leisure, adventure, sports and game education as well as musical/artistic-creative activities
- Capability of arranging (planning, organization, execution) various activities for and together with children and adolescents on one's own responsibility
- Understanding of the essence of communication and a profound knowledge of strategic ways to solve conflicts of any kind

Module III : Jurisdictional competence

- Profound skills in basics of law, including the specific legal status of a youth group leader, the duty of supervision, legal commitment as well as youth prevention
- Knowledge of organization and functionality of specific structures of youth welfare (for example youth welfare office, free supporters of youth aid) as well as knowledge of association structures (incl. legal basics)
- Skills in acquiring sponsors and financial help for youth welfare and associative work
